


OUR RECYCLING PROJECT

UBC ZERO WASTE GOALS



IMPLEMENT MULTI-STREAM RECYCLING STATIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS ACROSS CAMPUS BY END OF 2015, TARGETING FOOD SCRAPS COLLECTION BY MID-2015.



INCREASE OVERALL DIVERSION RATES TO 70 PER CENT DIVERSION BY 2016, AND 80 PER CENT DIVERSION BY 2020.

DECREASE OPERATIONAL WASTE DISPOSAL TO LANDFILL/INCINERATION STEADILY, DESPITE CAMPUS GROWTH, TOWARD THE LONG-TERM ASPIRATION OF A ZERO-WASTE CAMPUS.

SURVEY...

Assesses the sustainability literacy of varsity athletes, to better understand how they view the environmental impact of their sport.

Asks...

- Athlete's understanding of sustainability
- Perception of team and venue's environmental impact
- Solutions to decrease environmental impact

- How do you think your sports team impacts the environment?
- What suggestions do you have for your team to improve it's environmental impact?





UBC Recycling Implementation Model



Potential Options for Recycling Locations



Transcontinental

- -accepts used and unused
- -will process branded jerseys
- -will pickup
- -possibility for buy back
- -partnership
- -located in Surrey, BC



Cann-Amm Exports Inc

-accepts used and unused
 -clothing is all downcycled
 -plant is based in India

Assumptions:

- The amount of clothes per team will be consistent, and therefore the sorting time per team will be consistent
- All clothing would have otherwise been thrown out
- Hanging scale will be used to weigh
- Each team will be given one 32 Gallon Green Brute Container with lid

2.2 lbs/athlete/semester = 4.4 lbs/athlete/year (assume 8 month school year)

= 4.4 lbs/athlete/year * 762 athletes = 3,352.8 lbs/year
= 3,352.8 lbs/year * \$0.15/lbs = \$502.92/year
= \$502.92/year * 5 years = \$2,514.60/5 years

*Opportunities to include staff and coaches (approximately 100) and sport fans

Recommendations

- Create a position for an athletics sustainability coordinator (work learn/ paid)
- TAC sustainability representative
- Host zero-waste game day events
- Purchase recyclable and lower-impact gear
- Purchase "sort it out" bins for all athletics facilities
- Pursue LEED certification for new gym and stadium
